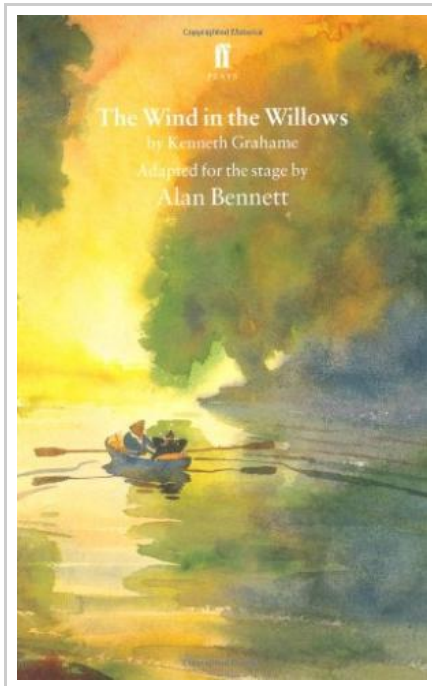




The Wind in the Willows (Main)
