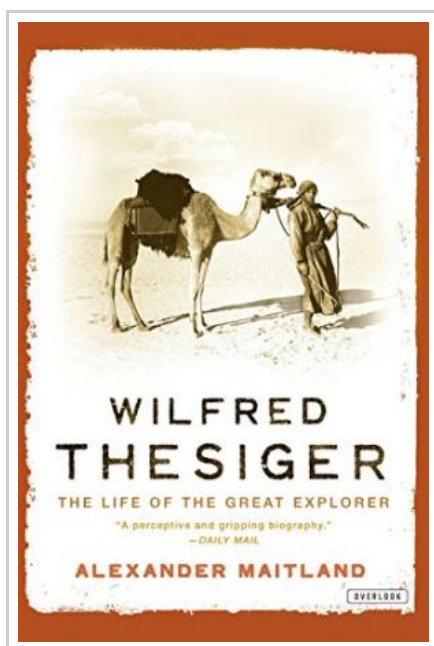



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Wilfred Thesiger: The Life of the Great Explorer

Perhaps the last of the great explorer-adventurers, Wilfred Thesiger (1910-2003) traveled extensively through some of the most remote places on earth: the mountains of western Asia, the marshes of Iraq, the Empty Quarter of the Arabian Desert and produced books like *The Marsh Arabs*, *Arabian Sands*, and his memoir *The Life of My Choice*. In World War II he was awarded Britain's Distinguished Service Order for leading Sudanese troops against the Italians in Ethiopia, while his postwar travels earned him the Lawrence of Arabia Medal, the Livingstone Medal, and the Burton Memorial Medal. Alexander Maitland, Thesiger's longtime friend and editor, gives us a close-up portrait of this remarkable explorer, hunter, conservationist, writer, and photographer, discussing his family influences, his friendships with Arabs and Africans, and his now-acknowledged homosexuality.
