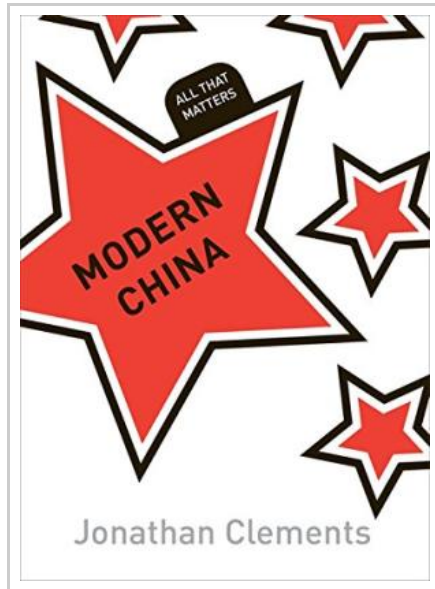




Modern China
