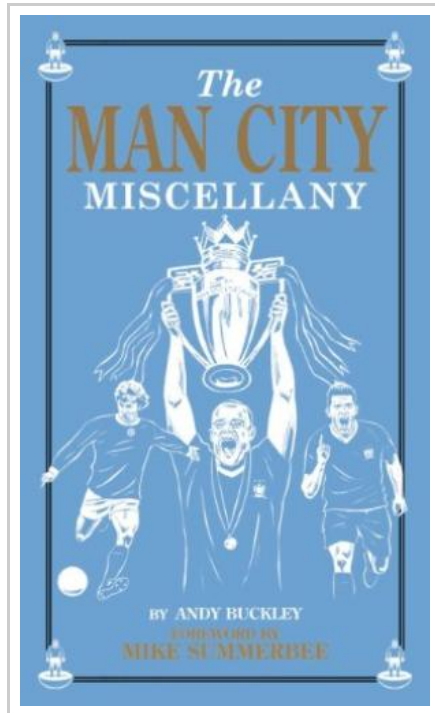




The Man City Miscellany
