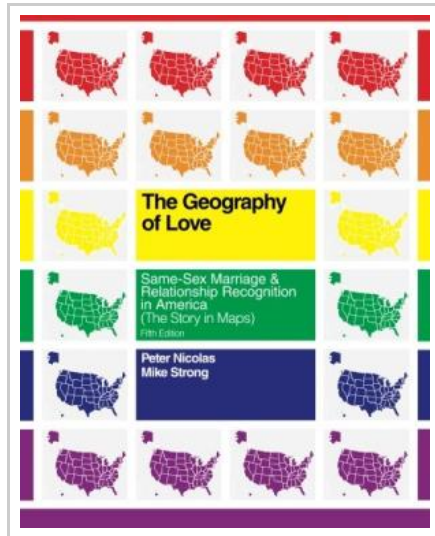




The Geography of Love Same-Sex Marriage Relationship Recognition in America The Story in Maps
